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taking over and establishment of Medical College at Anantapur.

5. The Government after careful examination of the above matter have decided to take over the Medical College at Anantapur and establish the same as a Government Medical College at Anantapur. Further, the Government have also decided to release an amount of Rs.190.27 lakhs during the financial year 1999-2000 towards recurring and non-recurring expenditure and also for creation of the posts which are required at the time of inception of the new Medical College for admitting 100 students as required under section 10 (A) of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

6. The Government after careful examination of the above matter hereby accord sanction for release of an amount of Rs.34.22 crores to Director of Medical Education over a period of 5 years from 1999-2000 to 2003-2004 for taking over of Anantapur Medical College Trust and establishment of a Government Medical College at Anantapur. Further the Government also accord sanction for release of an amount of Rs.190.27 lakhs (Rupees one crore ninety lakhs and twenty seven thousand only) during this financial year 1999-2000 towards recurring and non-recurring expenditure as detailed below:-

7. The Government also accord sanction to the Director of Medical Education for creation of posts which are required at the time of inception of the new Medical College as indicated in the Annexure-I to this order and permit her for filling up of the said posts following prescribed procedure. Further, the Government also accord permission to Director of Medical Education for obtaining services on contract basis from service

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providers as indicated in Annexure-II and III to this order with an estimated cost of Rs. 21.22 lakhs during 1999-2000 without actual creation of the posts in the college.
