Sir/Madam,

I am directed to inform that the compliance verification assessment of the physical and the other teaching facilities available at Govt. Medical College, Ananthapuram, A.P. under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada was carried out by the Council assessors on 21st March, 2018. The said assessment report along with the previous assessment reports (11th October 2017, 21st July 2017, 4th May 2017, 11th November, 2016 and 16th & 17th May, 2016) was considered by the Executive Committee at its meeting held on 24.03.2018 and it was decided as under:-

"The Executive Committee of the Council considered the compliance verification assessment report (21st March, 2018) along with the previous assessment reports (11th October, 2017, 21st July, 2017, 4th May, 2017, 11th November, 2016 and 16th & 17th May, 2016) and decided to recommend that recognition of MBBS degree granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Govt. Medical College, Ananthapuram, A.P. be continued restricting the number of admission to 100 students."

The Executive Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Sections 8(3)(2), 8(3)(3) & 8(3)(4) of the Establishment of Medical Colleges Regulations (Amendment), 2010 (Part II) dated 16th April, 2010 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

- 8 (3) ...
- (2) The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
 - (3) The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.
 - (4) Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub clause (a) supra shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute."

The above decision of the Executive Committee has been approved by the Oversight Committee on 28.03.2018.

It is further to inform you that your institution is fully responsible to fulfill and maintain norms including the infrastructure both physical and human resource, teaching faculty and clinical material etc. throughout, as stipulated in Regulation of Medical Council of India. In case false/wrong declaration of fabricated documents have been used for procuring the approval of Continuation of recognition by the Council and the said misconduct is brought to notice or comes to the knowledge of MCI at any stage, your institution is liable not to be considered for approval of continuation of recognition with the annual intake capacity of 100 students and this
